Dear Parent/ Carer

We approach the end of another busy term at Fleetwood High. Students are working hard in lessons and making good progress. Year 11 are now only a matter of 20 school days from starting their GCSEs and we are delivering a full programme of revision in school over the Easter holiday, please make sure your son/daughter attends the sessions in their subjects (see the School website for further details). Please encourage your son/daughter to revise at home as well. Students will not fulfil their potential without revision at home. Equally, Year 9 students now need to be starting to prepare for their end of Key Stage 3 SAT exams, which take place in early June by revising thoroughly at home.

Beyond the classroom, we have had sporting successes on the football field, another fantastic result from our 'STEM team' in the inter-school Science Competition, a wonderful performance from our School Choir at Blackpool Winter Gardens, along with a wide range of school trips and other extra-curricular activities.

As we move towards the final term of the year, could I please ask for support from parents with the following measures which we are putting in to place in the summer term, which will ensure we are in line with Cardinal Allen and Millfield.

- Mobile phones/ear phones should not be used at all or indeed be visible in the school building. We are happy for students to use them outside at break and lunchtime but not in lessons or on corridors between lessons. If mobile phones are visible in the building they will be confiscated. On the first occasion the phone will be returned at the end of the day and after this only to a parent.
- Fizzy drinks, such as Lucozade and other energy drinks, are banned in school. They have a high sugar content and affect the ability of students to concentrate in class rooms. If students are found with these drinks on them they will also be confiscated.
- Students must not wear coats, hoodies, tracksuit tops etc inside the school building. These again will be confiscated until the end of the day if worn in the building. Trainers must not be worn in school and students not wearing correct footwear will be isolated to complete their work in another area of the building. Blazers must be worn around school, though if it is hot they may be removed in lessons with the permission of the class teacher.


